Dear Parents,

Your child is invited to represent their school in the annual DASP Singing Festival with other first schools from DASP on **18th March 2019.** The festival involves a morning rehearsal during the school day and then an evening performance, which parents are invited to attend. The children will be walking to The Thomas Hardye School in the morning. They will be leaving school at 9am returning to school at approximately 1pm.

For the evening, the children need to be at The Thomas Hardye School Theatre at 6pm (the doors to the performance space will not open before 6 pm, so please do not arrive too early). Please enter the school via the main entrance on Queen's Avenue. There is ample parking in the main car park at the end of Queen's Avenue or on Queen's Avenue road itself.

The performance will start at 6.30pm and will last around 1 hour.

Due to the high number of students involved, we ask that each child brings a maximum of 2 adults with them to watch the performance, in order that everyone can be seated in the theatre.

Entrance to the performance is free. However, there will be a retiring collection to raise funds for DASP Music (registered charity 1162919). This money will then be used to fund musical projects such as this for the DASP schools in the future.

For the evening, children will need to wear their school uniform.
